

ShipStation / Sweetwater Logistics Integration Guide

Before Sweetwater Logistics can automatically pull orders from shipstation you will need to enable access to ShipStations Application Programming Interface (API).

Allowing third-party API access to your ShipStation account

To establish the API connection between Sweetwater Logistics and ShipStation, the following is required

- API Key
 - API Secret
1. From the ShipStation Vendor Portal, click on **API Settings**
 2. The required details are under the *API Keys* heading. If the keys are not displayed, click the **Generate API Keys** button.
 3. Email the API Key and API Secret to steve@sweetwaterlogistics.com with your company name in the subject line.
